

CANAAN NH
INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORM PA-38
NOTICE OF INTENT TO EXCAVATE

Line 1. Enter "Canaan"

Line 2. Obtain from tax bill or tax maps at town office.

Line 3. Name of road which allows access to excavation site.

Line 4. Lot size from tax bill or tax map.

Line 5. "Issue Date" found on the Planning Board issued Excavation Permit. If permit from Planning Board is not required, leave blank.

Line 6. Leave blank unless a valid report is found. Valid dates are between Aug 4, 1989 and Aug 4, 1991. There are no known reports in Canaan meeting line 6 requirements.

Line 7. Enter permit number of NH DES Alteration of Terrain Permit. If there is none, leave blank.

Line 8. Check this box if a Planning Board issued Excavation Permit is not required. Excavations incidental to another project, or less than 1,000 cubic yards, generally don't require such a permit.

Line 9. Include areas in all expired permits, all active permits, all unpermitted areas, and all reclaimed areas. Include all current and prior years. Include areas in future years which have been permitted. This is everything that has or will be excavated, as accurately as it can be estimated.

Line 10. Include all excavation areas in line 9 currently not reclaimed.

Line 11. Include all reclaimed areas in line 9.

Line 12. Enter estimated amount to be excavated in current and all future years. This is a best estimate, as it is difficult to forecast exact amount or quality of remaining material.

Line 13. First circle is the most commonly used, second circle must be recorded at registry, and third circle is public land.

Line 15. Estimate for tax year, which is April 1 through March 31.

Line 16. If this is the first PA-38 this tax year for this lot, use "ORIGINAL". If this is a second or later Form this year for this lot use "SUPPLEMENTAL". Revised estimates in same year are "SUPPLEMENTAL".

Line 17. Must be completed by owners.
