Meeting was called to order at 2:10 PM.

The following items were discussed;

We received a letter from Joe and Stella Butterfield granting permission to cut a dead oak tree, which is on their property adjacent to Wells Cemetery, overhanging the cemetery. This tree presents a potential danger of falling into the cemetery. As stated in October, John Pelkey Tree Work is currently booked through the rest of this year and cutting will be done in the spring.

We received permission from the Probate Court to apply funds from the Davis Trust to address water issues in any of the Town cemeteries providing we maintain a \$10,000.00 sum dedicated for water issues in Wells Cemetery.

Rules and regulations continue to be researched for a determination in the spring concerning how they will be adopted for all Canaan cemeteries.

The minutes of the October meeting were reviewed and approved and will be forwarded to the Town for publication.

Ellie Davis inquired about the corner markers for her family's plot in Canaan Street Cemetery. She stated it appears one of the markers for the plot beside hers is actually placed within her plot. The Trustees will contact Barry Geddes to check on this.
