

Cemetery Trustees Meeting

May 10

The meeting was called to order at 2:00 PM and the following items were discussed;

The minutes from the March and April meeting were reviewed and approved.

The location for the new well at Wells annex will be chosen at the June meeting to take place at that location on June 14 at 10:00. There will be a need for a small building to house a storage tank. The Historical Society will be contacted for any needed approval. The Trustees recommend a building approximately 12' x 12' to allow storage of maintenance equipment.

Phil Carter will check with John Pelkey regarding tree removal at Wells Cemetery.

Al Posnanski reports the 4H club completed the Scofield Cemetery cleanup on April 6th.

The Trustees decided it would be best to attach Cemetery rules as an addendum to each plot deed. The owners will be required to read and initial their understanding of the rules upon receipt of the deed.

The Town has hired an employee to assist Barry Geddes in the cemeteries.

Barry requests to burn ethanol free gas in the equipment to prolong engine life. It is available at Pleasant Valley Store in West Canaan. Barbara will check with Mike Samson about the possibility of a gas card for Barry for that purpose.

There is an issue at Wells Cemetery where vehicles are encroaching on some grave corner markers. The Trustees will look into obtaining some type of small posts and/or chain stringers to keep the vehicles within the existing roadway.
